St. Lawrence County Public Health Department is in search of:

**Public Health Educator**

**Salary:** \$65,825 with excellent benefits as described below

**Benefits:** Generous vacation and sick time allowance, Public Service Loan Forgiveness eligibility and the option to enroll in the St. Lawrence County's health insurance or opt out of the insurance and receive a buyout in the amount of \$2,000 for single coverage or \$4,000 for family.

**Duties of the position:** The term Public Health Educator shall mean a person who applies the principles of behavioral sciences in public health programs to foster the voluntary adaptation of behavior to improve or maintain health. The duties of this position involve responsibility for planning, organizing, coordinating and implementing educational activities and programs on health issues and concerns which affect public health needs and services. The incumbent surveys public health needs/problems and plans/organizes presentations, forums, and training sessions to meet those needs. The work is performed under the general supervision of a higher level supervisor. The incumbent does related work as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** EITHER:

- A) A baccalaureate degree in health education, health science, public health, health promotion, community health, or health communications from a regionally accredited or New York State-registered college or university; **or**
- B) A baccalaureate degree in education, nursing, epidemiology, wellness and fitness, or nutrition from a regionally accredited or New York State-registered college or university and one year experience in health education; **or**
- C) A baccalaureate degree in marketing, human services, social work or psychology from a regionally accredited or New York State-registered college or university and two years experience in health education; **or**
- D) A master's degree in public health or health education from a regionally accredited or New York State-registered college or university.

A local public health educator must satisfactorily complete 15 hours of continuing education in health education related topics approved by the New York State Health Department within one year of appointment.

**Additional Employment Information: This is a provisional appointment. The successful applicant will need to take a civil service examination and score within the top three interested candidates in order to be permanently appointed.**
