

**St. Lawrence County Government
Position Advertisement Form**

The St. Lawrence County Highway Department is in search of qualified applicants for the title of **Temporary Laborer** for a period not to exceed twelve (12) weeks during the summer of 2026. The incumbent will work 40 hours a week, Monday – Thursday, 6:30 AM – 4:30 PM at an hourly rate of \$18.46.

Duties of the position: Rakes and shovels asphalt to patch potholes or assist in the paving of roads; assists in the installation, maintenance and repair of sidewalks by shoveling, jack-hammering, laying forms, and pouring cement; assists in the installation, maintenance, and repair of pipeline by excavating, laying pipe, and backfilling; loads and unloads trucks; cuts brush, removes dead trees, plants grass, and mows lawns; cleans debris from parking lots and culverts; shovels snow and spreads salt; operates power tools and equipment such as saws, mixers, jackhammers, and mowers; acts as a flag person on street jobs; performs routine maintenance on water and sewer systems; cleans vehicles and buildings; operates motor equipment on a relief, emergency, or trainee basis.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Working knowledge of the care and use of common hand and power tools used in maintenance and construction; ability to perform routine physical labor; ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions; willingness to work in inclement weather; physical strength and endurance; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

Preference may be given to those candidates possessing a valid New York State operator's license, Class B.
