The work is performed under general supervision with wide latitude allowed for instructing, planning and making assignments to subordinates. Does related work as required.

- (C) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an Associate's Degree in Nursing and four (4) years of progressively responsible experience in professional nursing activities or in a program for individuals with mental health conditions or individuals with substance use disorders, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory position.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS: Licensure and current registration as a Registered Professional Nurse in New York State.
